APPLICATION DEADLINE (2x per year): JULY 15th and NOVEMBER 15TH
Applications must be postmarked by July 15th for fall term and November 15th for spring term.

Criteria for eligibility are as follows:

- Be enrolled as a member of Tlingit & Haida and registered to the **Seattle Community Council**.
- Be a full-time student attending, or planning to attend, an accredited community college, university, or technical school.
- Submit a completed application, including financial need information.
- Submit two letters of recommendation
- Submit an essay. Please limit length to two pages.
- Submit official transcripts from all colleges/post-secondary schools attended
 - High school transcripts are acceptable if applying prior to any post-secondary education.
