**APPLICATION DEADLINE (2x per year): JULY 15th and NOVEMBER 15TH
Applications must be postmarked by July 15th (fall term) and November 15th (spring term)
There will be no exceptions!**

Criteria for eligibility are as follows:

- Must be enrolled as a member of Central Council Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska- **Seattle Community Council.**
- Be a full-time student attending, or planning to attend, an accredited community college, university or technical school.
- Submit a completed application, including financial need information.
- Submit two letters of recommendation
- Submit an essay. Please limit length to two pages.
- Submit official transcripts from all colleges/post-secondary schools attended
High school transcripts are acceptable if applying prior to any post-secondary education. Provide proof of enrollment.
- Sign and Date the Statement of Accuracy for Students

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Tlingit & Haida Washington Chapter members of all ages and situations who are committed to continuing their education are encouraged to apply.
